Guidelines for Applicants

## [Purpose]

To support young foreign researchers or doctors doing excellent research in otorhinolaryngology and related fields in Japan

## [Requirements]

Foreign researchers or doctors who do research in otorhinolaryngology and related fields (any nationality is accepted) in Japan

(Number of grant recipients) Approximately three recipients

[Obligations for application]

- 1. Applicant who will come to Japan in the very near future.
- 2. Applicant who conducts research in otorhinolaryngology and related fields.
- 3. Applicant who will stay in Japan more than three months during the period of April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022
- 4. Only one person can apply from one organization.
- 5. Recommender must be a sponsor of SPIO.
- 6. Past recipient of this grant who wants to reapply must have submitted a report or interim report.

[Amount of grant] JPY 250 thousand per month

[Period of grant]

Three month to one year (may be adjusted depending upon the total number of grant recipients)

(Application period) From July 1 to August 31, 2021 (Japan Standard Time)

Formal decision on the awarding of grant will be made at SPIO Board of Directors meeting and will be informed to each applicant on October, 2021

- Grant recipients should keep contact with SPIO after returning home and work for international contribution.
- Grant recipients must submit a summary report of their research promptly after the research is completed. Organization where applicant fails to do so will lose right to apply for this grant.
- Application form once submitted cannot be replaced.
- Personal information in application form is not used except for this selection.
